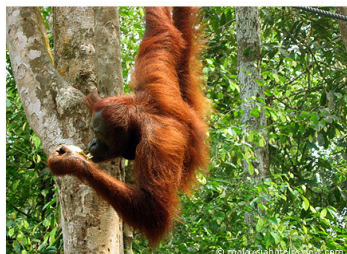

DAY 1: SINGAPORE → KUCHING (D)

Depart for Kuching on SilkAir. Meet and greet at Kuching International Airport and transfer to hotel. Seafood dinner in a local restaurant

DAY 2: KUCHING (B/L)

Pick up from hotel and travel with your chef to a local market for ingredients shopping. Thereafter, proceed to a local restaurant and prepare the ingredients to wipe up a dish of famous Bamboo chicken (Chicken cooked in bamboo tube). As you go along, learn the various types of ingredients, herbs and raw material used for the preparation.

Continue your day with a City tour of Kuching. One of your stops is the renowned Sarawak Museum, reputed as one of the world's best museum. Here, collections of archaeological exhibits are displayed.

Next, proceed to the Kuching Waterfront, where all the hustle and bustle of the city goes by. Highlights of the city are the Clock Tower, Square Tower, Astana – the palace, Fort Margherita and the Malay Village which is across a river. From the Waterfront, the journey continues towards north. There, you will see the State Mosque, the Court House and the Parliament building. The tour ends with a visit to the Pangkalan Sapi that overlooks the city.

DAY 3: SEMMONGGOH ORANG UTAN & IBAN LONGHOUSE (B/L/D)

Your morning starts with a visit Semmenggoh Orang Utan Rehabilitation Centre, which is situated 30 minutes away from the city. Each of the brown and rust-colored shaggy fur Orang Utans weighs between 50 to 90 kg. Their life span ranges from 45 years living in the wild to about 60 years when in captivity.

Orang Utans are usually found in tropical swamps and mountainous forests. They use twigs and branches to construct a large nest-platform up on a tree to sleep in the nights. Animal lovers and outdoor enthusiasts should not miss this excursion as it features a 740 - acre sanctuary. Feedings are done twice, daily. Get the experience of seeing Orang Utans emerging from the forest to be fed by the park's rangers. Most of the Orang Utans in this sanctuary were taken from illegal captivities or rescued from the forest. They are then trained patiently and rehabilitated for the returns to the wild, to fend for themselves.

*Sighting of orang utan is not guaranteed.

A short visit to native market in Serian, thereafter travel to Iban Longhouse located along Lenemak River. The Guesthouse for accommodation is built near to the longhouse with basic facilities. At night, a motorized generator powers the longhouse. You will be greeted with the Iban's welcome dance and treated to their local rice wine - Tuak upon arrival. Overnight in guesthouse**.

It is a custom to present a small gift to the Iban villagers, recommended items are biscuits, candies, cigarettes etc. guest can also purchase stationery like exercise books or pencils for the children. A stop will be made at a local shop to make your purchase before you leave for the longhouse. Cost is normally shared among other guests. Estimated cost per person is RM20-25.

DAY 4: KUCHING TO SINGAPORE (B)

Transfer to Kuching and enjoy local lunch (at own expense). Thereafter transfer to airport for your departure flight.
