DAY 1: SINGAPORE → SIEM REAP (D)

Meet and greet at Siem Reap airport and transfer to your hotel. Dinner at Café Indochine.

DAY 2: SIEM REAP (B/L/D)

Early morning drive about 6km to south gate Angkor Thom before turning left to the three-temple to embark a boat which takes around 15minutes in 2.5km along the canal. Enjoy your continental breakfast at temple. Southwest PRASAT CHRUNG: corner shrine, built of sandstone & dedicated to Avalokiteshvara. Then we proceed to Angkor Wat, the crowning jewel of Khmer architecture. The largest, best preserved and most religiously significant of the Angkor temples that impresses visitors by its sheer scale & beautiful layout. To approach the temple, first cross the vast moat, continuing along a broad causeway lined with naga balustrades. At the main building ascend through a series of galleries & courtyard before reaching the central sanctuary for an overview of the countryside. On the way stop to enjoy the intricate stone carvings with some 1.700 Apsara (celestial dancers), sculpted into the walls. Along the outer gallery wall runs the longest bas-relief in the world which narrates stories from the Hindu mythology, including the famous Churning of the Ocean of Milk.

Visit Angkor Thom, a fortified city covers an area of 10 square km. Enter by the monumental SOUTH GATE before proceeding to the Terrace Of The Elephants & The Terrace of the Leper Kings, former spaces for public ceremonies. Visit Baphuon, Royal Enclosure & Phimeanakas before continuing to the mysterious Bayon Temple. Explore the galleries of beautifully preserved bas reliefs and ascend narrow stairs to reach the central sanctuary, where you will find giant stone faces smiling at you from every angle. Thereafter you will travel 26km from Siem Reap to a local village to experience homestay with the villagers. A cooking class will be arranged at the homestay and you get to enjoy the food you have cooked after which you spend your night at the village.

DAY 3: LOCAL VILLAGE - SIEM REAP (B/L/D)

Enjoy breakfast & sunrise at homestay terrace before touring the village. Experience a taste of 'real' Cambodia local lifestyle riding on ox cart visiting sugar palm makers, rice padi fields & vegetable plantation, handicraft centre & butterfly farm. Back to homestay for lunch. Then transfer back to Siem Reap to have your dinner and overnight stay.

DAY 4: SIEM REAP (B/L/D)

Sightseeing in Siem Reap visiting local school, visit traditional medicine shop by Kru Sreng Wat Bo.

**** Optional Goodwish Ceremony at Pagoda **** can be arranged if required (A Goodwish Ceremony at Pagoda is a ceremony done by the monk/priest to pray for you, blessings will be done with perfumed water and jasmine flowers. You will need to purchase some items for the monk such as cotton, shoes, tea, coffee, milk, candle in a box. Items will cost from USD\$5-10 per box)
 Overnight in Siem Reap.

DAY 5: SIEM REAP → SINGAPORE (B)

Free at own leisure until transfer to airport for your flight back to Singapore.
