DAY 1: SINGAPORE → KOTA KINABALU (D)

Depart for Kota Kinabalu on SilkAir. Meet and greet at Kota Kinabalu International Airport and transfer to hotel. Dinner at a local restaurant.

DAY 2: KOTA KINABALU (B/L/D)

Assemble at 0900hrs in hotel lobby for your transfer to Papaga Village (Paper District), a place to experience kampong life style. The journey takes about 45minutes. Built on 30 acres of green spurs of hills, valleys and forested ridge, it offers a variety of simple and peaceful kampong activities and recreational facilities. The villagers grow padi, vegetable and herbs, rear poultry and fish to supplement their diet. There is always tranquility and feeling of contentment in the village. The days are usually quiet and relaxing. Nights are cool as families and friends gather to catch up over a few glasses of montoku (rice wine).

Upon arrival the guests will collect some ingredients from the garden for the cooking in one of the selected houses. After lunch then transfer back to hotel. Dinner at a local restaurant.

DAY 3: MARI – MARI CULTURAL VILLAGE (B/L/D)

0900-1300HRS Upon arrival, you will be greeted and briefed on the village rules as you prepare a journey into prehistoric Borneo. Get greeted by the Chief and go through a Welcome Ceremony before walking through a suspension bridge to enter the village.

The visit starts at the Dusun house where you witness a demonstration on traditional way of tobacco cutting. Next, enter a hut that specialized cooking using bamboos and also see the Montoku (rice wine) making process. Your journey is followed by a visit to the Rungus Longhouse. Here, you learn how to start a fire without lighters or matches and see how ethnic rattan bangles are made by the villagers to supplement their income. Be awed by a demonstration on the olden ways of producing ropes, vests, flooring, wall covers etc. made from tree bark at the Lundayeh House. Next, a visit to the Bajau House to watch the locals prepare Jala (local cake) and Pandan juice awaits you. Inside, you will see a myriad of colourful antique ancestral objects plus a decorative bridal parlour for your photo-taking pleasure. The visit is incomplete without a visit to the headhunters' tribe, Murut Longhouse! Here is where you witness a demonstration on blowpipe making and Lansaran (traditional trampoline-like floor).

Be entertained by a cultural performance, do some souvenir/hand-made product shopping before you bid farewell to friends from village and return to 21st century as you get transferred back to hotel. Dinner at a local restaurant.

DAY 4: LOK KAWI WILDLIFE PARK (B/L)

Lok Kawi Wildlife Park (or Lok Kawi Zoo) is about 15km from Kota Kinabalu city. Visitors can see Borneo and Malaysia wild animals such as orang utans, proboscis monkey, Asian elephants, rhino, hornbill birds, tigers etc.

Lunch is fish slice soup with fresh tomatoes at local restaurant (hawker style).

*Sighting of orang utan is not guaranteed.

DAY 5: KOTA KINABALU → SINGAPORE (B)

Free at own leisure until transfer to airport for your flight back to Singapore.
